## What's Been Happening in 2020

*At this moment we have no outreaches or speaking at any churches planned due to the COVID-19.*

*All our outreaches and speaking engagements that were arranged have been cancelled. We are hoping that we will be able to do some towards the end of the year.*

*We have been reaching out to many of the Indigenous people here in this nation via our live streaming through Facebook on Sunday and Wednesday evenings.*

*It has been amazing where God has taken this so far. We are reaching out to many of the communities throughout this state—South Australia. We have also reached up in Northern Territory and Queensland as well.*

*We also have someone from Canada who comes on every week.*

*We are going to continue the live streaming, even after all the restrictions have eased as we believe that God wants us to continue to reach out to those that cannot get to church or a connect/bible study group as they are in remote areas.*



*We also starting an Indigenous Smart Recovery Program for those who have addictions, substance abuse, eating disorders, anxiety, rejection etc. This will hopefully be commencing in the next month.*

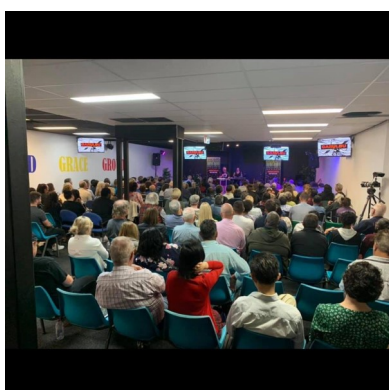
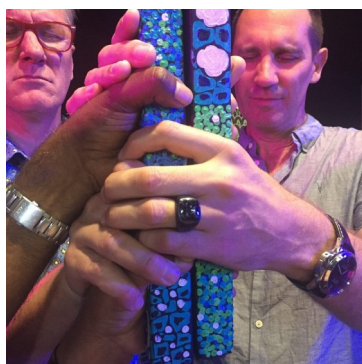
